<b>School Tuition</b>	<p>The Tuesday / Thursday Class is \$225.00 per month (for 9 months). A \$200.00 discount is given if tuition is paid in full for the entire year; prior to or on the first day of school. Tuition, paid monthly, is due by the first school day of each month (September-May). All checks are made payable to ‘Auburn Grace Community Church’ or ‘AGCC’. If finances are a concern, please contact the Preschool Director.</p> <p>A pre-paid tuition refund is available for any full months remaining in the current school year with 30 days written notification.</p> <p>Tuition covers all school materials, homework handouts, classroom supplies and teachers’ salaries. Extra expenses that may be incurred include: field trips, class t-shirt and snacks (parents provide on a rotation basis).</p>
<b>Registration Fee</b>	Non-refundable new student registration fee is \$100.00 which is due at the time of enrollment.

## Curriculum

We use a variety of curriculums throughout our school year to reach our educational goals with our students. *FUNDamentals for Learning* is our primary curriculum. We also use *Zoo-phonics*, *Rod and Staff* and *About Three* from *Christian Light Publishing*, and our music curriculum is taken from *Musik Garten*. We are highly interactive in all we do, and encourage you to be so with your child at home. Periodically you will receive worksheets in your student's take home folder that you can use to re-enforce learning at home.

### **Our curriculum provides for all areas of a child's development:**

spiritual	emotional	social
physical	cognitive	creative

### **Daily lesson plans include:**

- Bible Time – Biblical virtues using Bible stories, puppet stories, life application examples and scripture memory.
- Movement Time - Working on large motor skills.
- Manipulative and Table Time – Working on fine motor skills.
- Fundamental Time – Developing age appropriate cognitive skills.

Our curriculum goals are realistic and attainable for most children in the age range for which they are designed. Below is an overview of our curriculum guide within most areas of learning.

### **Cognitive Skills**, we believe, should not be limited to:
