

Life Group Discussion Questions – July 21, 2019

2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, <u>accurately</u> <u>handling</u> the word of truth.

QUICK REVIEW

- 1. How is God speaking to us today through the person and life of Jesus?
- 2. How is Jesus the 'topic' of the Old Testament? How is Jesus the 'purpose' of the New Testament?

MY STORY

- 1. When God to speak to us, it shows that He desires to be understood? What does this tell us about Him?
- 2. When we talk about the clarity of Scripture we do not mean that everything in the Bible is 100% understandable, but that God communicated exactly what He wanted to speak. Do you have a Biblical truth that is still confusing to you?
- 3. Can you name a time when you thought the Bible said something, but when you later studied the Bible directly, you realized it did not say what you thought it said?

GOING DEEP

- 1. Read 2 Timothy 1:13-14. What does this passage show us about being determined to interpret the Bible accurately?
- 2. Understanding your Bible requires a few simple tools of study? How familiar are you with these tools?
- 3. What are the dangers of studying the Bible all alone or without using the proper study tools?

- 5. Read Acts 2:42. Why did the early Christians sit under Bible teaching together? What benefit is that to the church?
