

Life Group Questions – November 10th, 2019

Deuteronomy 7:9 *'Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, who keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments'*

QUICK REVIEW

1. What happens when Kingdom ambassadors are negligent of their duties? What's at stake? Are some of their responsibilities more important than others? If so, which ones? Explain.
2. In order for a true conversion experience to happen, must there be confession **and** repentance? Can't we just confess our sins? What is the significance of repentance? Discuss the differences between a child saved at an early age and an adult coming into the saving knowledge of Christ later in life.

MY STORY

1. In what ways are Christians unfaithful to God? To others? How does God show His faithfulness to His people? How has He shown His faithfulness to you? (see Luke 16:10-13)
2. Name three tests of faith that the people of Hebrews 11 had to overcome. Have you faced anything similar? Do you think you might? Why or why not?
3. Is there a brother or sister in Christ who consistently encourages you in your faith? In what ways does their faith inspire you? Are you an encouragement to others in the same way? Why or why not?

GOING DEEP

1. How does God's record of faithfulness in others' lives impact your faith? Why should God's immutability be a cornerstone of our faith? In what areas of your life (or ministry) do you think He is calling you to "step out of the boat?"
2. What have you done, or could you do, that may encourage someone else to put their trust in Jesus for the first time?
3. How does meditating (not memorizing) God's Word serve to grow your faith *and* your faithfulness? What passage you mediated on recently accomplished this? Explain.

PUTTING IT TOGETHER:

1. What do you think are some of the challenges to living out each point?
2. Which of the above teaching points are most important for **you** to remember?
