

C2:7 Personal Growth Plan

Part 1 – Salvation

Colossians 1:13, ‘*For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son.*’

KNOW it! – What is genuine Salvation?

- Bible word ‘**Saved**’ = rescued **from** something, then transferred **to** something better Col. 1:13

► Rescued **from**:

- **Penalty** of Sin John 3:16; Romans 6:23
- **Power** of Sin Romans 6:6, 16-18
- **Presence** of Sin 1 John 3:2

► Transferred **to**:

- God **Justifies** you = ‘*just as if I*’ never had sinned
Romans 5:1-2; Ephesians 1:11-13
 - God **Sanctifies** you = transform to be more like Jesus
Romans 6; 2 Cor. 5:21
 - God **Glorifies** you = forever perfection state
Philippians 3:20-21
- Once launched salvation is an **irreversible** process

LIVE it! – **Repentance, Gratitude, Worship, Transformation, and Witnessing** are the elements of authentic salvation

WRITE it! – Your **salvation** story; your **transformation** story

SHARE it! – **say** it, **post** it, **send** it!

Life Group Discussion Questions – June 28, 2020

Colossians 1:13-14 “For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

QUICK REVIEW

1. In revisiting Pastor Greg’s sermon on Philippians 4:11, he stated that the Apostle Paul had “learned to be content whatever the circumstances.” What specifically had he learned? How can we truly be content in the same way?
2. What happens when we feel pressured to give or to serve? What makes us reluctant to do so? Read 2 Corinthians 9:8. What promise does God give to believers who give generously? How should we be managing the resources that He has given us?

MY STORY

1. Have you ever experienced a falling-out with a person that you love but were ultimately reconciled with them? How long did the disruption last? What events moved the relationship towards restoration? How has your relationship changed with them as a result?
2. What is the definition of rescue? What is the role of “danger” in a situation requiring rescue? What is the definition of restoration? Compare and contrast rescue and restoration?
3. Describe the circumstances that characterized your life before your salvation as they relate to what or who God used to eventually bring you to salvation in Christ. What realization did you come to that finally motivated you to receive Christ?

GOING DEEP

1. Read Romans 3:21-26 and 2 Corinthians 5:20-21. Justification is God’s declaring those who receive Christ to be righteous, based on Christ’s righteousness being imputed to the accounts of those who receive Christ. How does Christ’s righteousness become our righteousness? At what specific point are we declared righteous by God?
2. Read Romans 5:18-19. Discuss how this passage gives the believer the assurance of salvation. Whether we sense it or not, what begins to happen in us at the moment of our salvation?
3. As a group, identify the essential elements of an effective salvation story. Conversely, what parts of a salvation story should be minimized or omitted? Write out your salvation story, trying to keep it under 25 words. Memorize and share it with your Life Group the next time you meet.

2. Which of the above teaching points are most important for you to remember?



KNOW IT

Salvation: A new life by deliverance from sin and its consequences brought about by faith in Jesus Christ
