Life Group Questions for December 6th, 2020

DISCOVER

- 1. Read Revelation 21:1-6. Of all the descriptions given in these verses, which excite you the most? Why?
- 2. Read Revelation 22:1-7. Talk through the various elements of heaven described in this passage. What stands out to you? What can you learn about God from this paragraph?

EXPLORE

- In john's description (21:10-21) of the New Jerusalem he gives specific details as to its size. If this city were placed over a map of the United States how much territory would be used up just to by the New Jerusalem?
- 2. Look what is shared about the temple of God in the new city (21:22-27 & 22:5). What do these descriptions reveal to us about God and His love for people?

EXPEREINCE

- 1. How does knowing your future is firmly secure in the New City help you with the struggles of this life?
- 2. What specific hardships are you looking forward to being relieved (John uses 'tears, death, morning, crying, the curse)?
- 3. Until we enter the New City, what tools has God given to us to help us the trial of this life?

PRAY

Pray that God would both encourage your heart and help you to be an encouragement to others, knowing that our future is firmly established in the New City God has in store, knowing that all problems are temporal. Pray that God would increase your love for others and your patience to joyfully endure today.
