Life Group Discussion Questions – April 17, 2022

Acts 2:30-32 *And so, because he (David) was a prophet and knew that GOD HAD SWORN TO HIM WITH AN OATH TO SEAT one OF HIS DESCENDANTS ON HIS THRONE, he looked ahead and spoke of the resurrection of the Christ, that HE WAS NEITHER ABANDONED TO HADES, NOR DID His flesh SUFFER DECAY. This Jesus God raised up again, to which we are all witnesses.*

DISCOVER

1. What is your earliest memory of understanding Jesus' resurrection? How has the truth and promise found in the resurrection of Jesus impacted and changed your view of God?
2. Why is it important that Jesus raised HIMSELF from the dead? John 10:18
3. In what ways did Jesus fulfill the attributes of an omniscient, omnipresent and all-powerful God?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8. Why was it so important that Jesus appeared to hundreds after His resurrection? What was the impact on the disciples?

EXPLORE

1. Read John 1:35-42. Why did Andrew recognize Jesus as the Messiah so easily? How is your story of discovering Jesus similar or different than Andrew's?
2. Read Isaiah 53. Some have said that this passage was/is about someone other than Jesus. Discuss how the passage cannot be about anyone else but Jesus.
3. Why do you think the Jews missed that the Messiah would first come as a suffering Servant rather than a conquering King? If you had been in the position of the Jews, then what would have made you think you would have seen Jesus as Messiah?

EXPERIENCE

1. Your faith is actually rooted in the reliability of the resurrection. How might you share this truth with an unsaved friend? What objections should you anticipate?
2. What does a life look like that's lived in trusting in the resurrection? How should we see this in other believers?
3. If someone was to say that Jesus was a great teacher but not God, then how can you respond with Biblical truth?
4. Why did Jesus die for you?

PRAY

Pray... Our Gracious God and Father, we walk in boldness in this life by knowing that the grave cannot hold us; that we will be forever in Your presence. Thank You, Jesus, that in our place You received the punishment that brought us peace; that we are healed because of Your wounds; that our old selves are buried in the likeness of Your death and that we are raised to walk in new life. In You alone, Jesus, we are justified. May we receive You this day not only as our Redeemer but as our Lord. For the sake of Your Glorious Name. Amen.
