School Tuition 3-Day/Week Program: \$350 per month (for 9 months)

2-Day/Week Program: \$250 per month (for 9 months-preschool only)

• Monthly tuition is due on the first school day of each month (September-May)and may be paid online, credit card, cash, or check made out to 'Auburn Grace Community Church' or 'AGCC'.

- A 10% discount is given if tuition is paid in full for the entire year; prior to or on the first day of school. A prepaid tuition refund is available for any full months remaining in the current school year with 30 days written notification of withdrawal.
- We also offer a 10% sibling discount.
- Tuition covers all school materials, curriculum, and classroom supplies. Extra expenses that may be incurred include field trips.

Learning Groups Tiny Tots - typically 3-year-olds

Pre-K - typically 4-year-olds- moving on to kindergarten the next year

Combo Class - typically includes 3/4-year-olds not going to Kindergarten

the next year

Each group works on a curriculum specifically designed for a specific age

group and developmental stage.
