# Life Group Discussion Questions - May 5, 2024

**Philippians 3:12-14;** <sup>12</sup> 'Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, **but I press on** so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus. <sup>13</sup> Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and **reaching forward to what lies ahead**, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.'

## **DISCOVER**

- 1. Have you ever been involved in a project that took years to achieve? What kind? How did the project feel in the middle of the process?
- 2. How has God spiritually matured you over the years? Can you name one area of spiritual growth that has taken a long time to mature?

# **EXPLORE**

- 1. As you think back to the time when you were introduced to Jesus, where were you and who introduced you to Jesus? If you started going to church as an adult, what brought you to the point of deciding to go to church?
- 2. As you think of your unchurched co-workers and neighbors, do you think they would come to church if you invited them? Or do you think they would come to a neutral event to build a relationship, then be more willing to come to church?
- 3. Neutral events are called 'bridge' events where people are invited to an event that is not a church service in order to build relationships, and then attend a church service. What events does AGCC currently do throughout the year to help unchurched people come onto our campus?

- 1. Would you be willing to help connect to unchurched people by helping at a 'bridge' event?
- 2. What passions or abilities do you have that can be used at a 'bridge' event?
