<b>School Tuition</b>	<b>3-Day/Week Program:</b> \$375 per month (for 9 months) <b>2-Day/Week Program:</b> \$275 per month (for 9 months-preschool only) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Monthly tuition is due on the first school day of each month (September-May) and may be paid on PayPal, credit card, cash, or check made out to ‘Auburn Grace Community Church’ or ‘AGCC’.</li><li>• A 10% discount is given if tuition is paid in full for the entire year; prior to or on the first day of school. A prepaid tuition refund is available for any full months remaining in the current school year with 30 days written notification of withdrawal.</li><li>• We also offer a 10% sibling discount.</li><li>• Tuition covers all school materials, curriculum, classroom supplies, and field trips.</li></ul>

**Preschool Curriculum:** *Zoo-phonics* for alphabet letters and sounds  
*Rod & Staff, Scholastic*, and other sources are included to create a well-rounded set of learning tools  
*Little Learners* Bible curriculum-Bible memory verses, songs, & crafts. We teach God’s creation, the fall of man, and Jesus as our Redeemer.  
*Chapel* once a quarter  
*Enrichment activities:* science experiments, cooking, musical instruments, singing, guest speakers, holiday parties and field trips

**Daily Routine:** Manipulatives – developing fine motor skills through play  
Calendar & Academic Time – age-appropriate cognitive skills  
Snack Time – please bring a water bottle and healthy snack daily  
Movement – practicing large and small motor skills  
Bible Time – Bible stories, character, crafts, and scripture memory  
Art/Craft Time – guided creativity with various art genres

**Cognitive Skills:** Learn and develop understanding of: colors, letters, shapes, numbers, time, sequencing, and nature

**Fine Motor Skills:** cutting coloring drawing tracing painting mixing  
tearing matching pasting lacing stacking sorting  
patterns puzzles punching building sequencing instruments

**Large Motor Skills:** tricycles hopscotch climbing parachute tossing  
bean bags obstacle courses marching balloons balls  
tumbling water play running jumping galloping

**Learning Groups** **Tiny Tots/PreK** - 3-4 year-olds  
**TK** - typically 4-5 year-olds- moving on to kindergarten the next year  
Each class has curriculum specifically designed for a specific age group and developmental stage.

**Parent Involvement** We love our parents’ involvement and invite you to support our school as much as you’d like. Please feel free to attend field trips, help with holiday/birthday celebrations, help with clean up or an art project or read a book to us! We do require parents and all approved visitors to sign in upon arrival on campus.
