A NOTE FROM PASTOR PHIL

Hello Church Family,

How exciting it is to be re-clarifying our desire to reach our **neighbors and the nations** with the good news of Jesus. From the time I first started going to church and Sunday School as a kid I regularly heard how much God loves all people and all people groups. Our church back then would do local activities and programs to share Jesus with the neighbors. Missionaries would share stories of how God used them to reach the nations. I clearly understood and fell in love with Missions because I knew it was dear to the heart of God.

Throughout the years God has used our congregation over and over again to impact our neighbors here in the Foothills and several nations around the world. We, as a faith community, have loved sharing the gospel in a variety of ways. So many of you reading this have been a part of those impact opportunities and have your own personal stories of how God used you.

Recently, we changed the name of our Missions team and department to 'IMPACT'. We are doing this strategically to more clearly communicate and to help you understand the **why and how** we believe God is calling us to make a difference. First, God desires more worshippers from all people groups and communities. So we obey His instructions for us to 'go' and make more disciples. Second, we want to love our neighbors and the nations because God loves them and desires their best, which is to know Him.

Finally, we know that genuinely loving our **neighbors and the nations** is living proof that Jesus is real! Therefore we want to make an IMPACT through prayer, sharing the gospel, caring for the hurting, going to where they are, not simply asking them to attend church. We encourage you to engage with us to make an IMPACT for Jesus.

WHAT IS THE GREAT COMMISSION?

When Jesus returned to heaven after His resurrection, He left His followers explicit instructions. They were both for the people who were there with Him that day and for every follower of Jesus who would come after them. He said, “Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you” (Matthew 28:19-20, New International Version). This instruction is known as the “Great Commission” because these words represent a critical assignment for the church as His people await His return. (Definition from www.cru.org)

WHAT IS DISCIPLESHIP?

Discipleship is a journey of intentional decisions leading to maturity in your relationship with Jesus so that you become more like Him in your attitudes, focus and ultimately behavior. It requires a commitment from the potential disciple and the disciple-makers. It's not something that happens by accident or overnight, and it can't be completed in a six-week class. This is a lifelong commitment to follow God with your whole self and to both learn from and eventually teach others about how to follow Him.

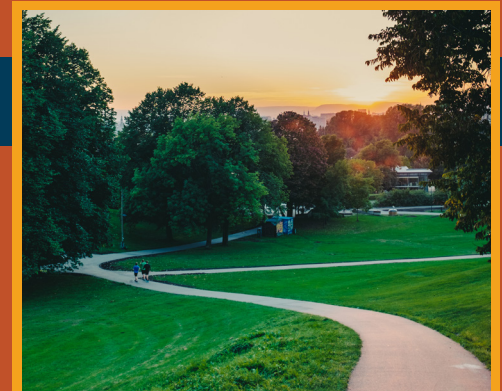

UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUP

An identifiable group of people distinguished by a distinct culture, language, or social class who lack a community of Christians able to evangelize the rest of the people group without outside help. The only opportunity for the people group to hear about salvation is through an “external witness.” Most missiologists consider 2% of the population becoming Christ followers as the “tipping point” at which the group is generally considered “reached” with the Gospel.

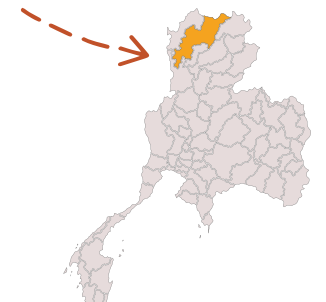


THE O'BRIEN FAMILY
