Since this is a homeschool.ng/brid.ng/brogram, work is also given throughout the week to be completed at home with parental guidance. Learning support will be available through your student's teacher. As we are limited in our time together, further subject instruction will need to be supplemented and/directed by the Standards, or charter connections with enrichment opportunities for families for students at home. Assessments, both formal and informal, will be conducted throughout the school year to determine proficiency and areas of growth and will be shared at Parent/Teacher conferences. We, as a staff, will partner with you and your child as we work towards academic success. Our objective is for students to demonstrate mastery in our subject areas, and be ready to move on to the next grade level.

School Tuition 3-Day/Week Program: \$375 per month (for 9 months).

- Monthly tuition is due on the first school day of each month (September-May) and may be paid through PayPal, cash, credit card or check made out to 'Auburn Grace Community Church' or 'AGCC'.
- A 10% discount is given if tuition is paid in full for the entire year prior to or on the first day of school. A prepaid tuition refund is available for any full months remaining in the current school year with 30 days written notification of enrollment cancellation.
- A 10% sibling discount is also available.
- Tuition covers all curriculum, materials, classroom and art supplies.

Registration Fee Non-refundable registration fee of \$150 is due at time of enrollment.
