School Tuition	3-Day/Week Program: \$350 per month (for 9 months)
	2-Day/Week Program: \$250 per month (for 9 months-preschool only)
	A 10% discount is given if tuition is paid in full for the entire year; prior to or on the first day of school.
	Tuition, paid monthly, is due on the first school day of each month (September-May). Checks are made payable to ‘Auburn Grace Community Church’ or ‘AGCC’ OR pay by credit card online.
	A pre-paid tuition refund is available for any full months remaining in the current school year with 30 days written notification of change of schools.
Registration Fee	Tuition covers all school materials, curriculum, and classroom supplies. Extra expenses that may be incurred include field trips or fund raisers.
	Non-refundable new student registration fee of \$150.00 is due at time of enrollment.
